

Role: APTA-NE Vice President

Specific Responsibilities: The Vice President serves as chairperson for the APTA-NE Panel on Education. The Panel on Education consists of the Education and Continuing Education Committees. The Vice President also serves as the liaison to the Executive Committee for the Nebraska Student Special Interest Group.

Term: 2-year term. Elected during the annual meeting in odd numbered years.

Committee Oversight: The APTA-NE Education Committee's main purpose is to plan and carry out educational opportunities for the Chapter membership at the Annual APTA-NE meeting. The Continuing Education Committee offers a service to members and non-members to review and, when appropriate, approve continuing education courses offered in the state of Nebraska.

Position Objective: As a member of the Executive Committee, it is the Vice President's duty to carry out the mandate of the Chapter as defined by the membership. The Executive Committee has full power and complete authority to perform all acts and to transact all business for and on behalf of the Chapter between meetings of the Chapter according to the bylaws of the Association.

Benefits: Through involvement and discussion with your peers, you will represent the Chapter to improve the quality and quantity of continuing education opportunities available to the membership. By working effectively with colleagues you will assist in the continued growth of the Association so that we all may continue to provide quality services of patients.

Time Commitment: The amount of time dedicated to this position is relative to the number applications submitted for continuing education review, the size of the annual conference, and the extent of programs and activities that the Executive Committee undertakes.
